

SUPPORT AND RELATED SERVICES:

Our ESY program is an extension of our robust educational and therapeutic program, where all support that is provided throughout the school year continues consistently during the ESY.

- Strong academic curriculum in small classroom settings

- Behavior team with BCBA to support student success
- Positive, support-based behavior modifications

- Infused technology; each student receives a Chromebook and access to academic support programs like Mindplay
- Continuation of related services including: Speech and Language, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, School Nurse services, Pull-out Reading support, Individual and Group Therapy, Psychiatric and Medication Monitoring
- Credit Recovery, as needed, for high school aged students
- Transitional Services for older students including Life Skills support, Job Sampling, College Visits as well as transportation and support at local community colleges
